Driving Directions:

From Winchester, Virginia, Route 7 and I-81:

Travel North on I-81 to Route 37/11 Exit, turn right off the exit onto Route 11 North. Travel 2 miles beyond Interstate 81 and turn right (South) onto Route 761 (Old Charles Town Road) for 1.4 miles. Bear right at Ellis' Grocery Store onto Jordan Springs Road for .9 miles. Go to the bottom of the hill, just before the little bridge, turn right into the entrance.

From Points East of Berryville, Virginia:

Travel West on Route 7, turn right onto Woods Mill Road (The second Route 660 you see at the light, Red Bud Run Subdivision). Continue on Woods Mill Road approximately 2 miles to the stop sign, turn left onto Jordan Springs Road. Go to the bottom of the hill, just over the little bridge, turn left into the entrance.
